

## Quincy Miller Bio

Quincy Miller is President and Vice Chairman of Eastern Bank, the largest and oldest mutual bank in the United States, with \$10 billion in assets and over 120 locations serving communities in eastern Massachusetts and southern and coastal New Hampshire. He is the immediate past Board Chair of the Urban League of Eastern Massachusetts and serves on the Board of Directors for The Greater Boston Food Bank, Bottom Line, Zoo New England and Board of Overseers for the Greater Boston YMCA.
